SPEAKERS REVIEW by Craig Kalemjian

Today's program was introduced by PDG **Bob Poole**, who was introduced by **Carol Hanson.**

Our speaker was PDG Jeff Cadorette, who was passionate (and then some) about Rotary Foundation. Jeff is the strategic advisor to Rotary's Annual Programs Fund, with emphasis on the Peacemaker's Fund.

The objective for the Rotary Foundation is "Every Rotarian Every Year". Rotary Foundation programs will allow a pivotal role in a more peaceful planet. We all own Rotary Foundation - it belongs to US.

Jeff exhorted each of us to become involved with the Foundations efforts, whether it be Polio eradication, Group Study Exchange or Matching grants. To emphasize, if the worlds population were represented by 100 people there would be: 57 Asians, 21 Europeans, 14 from the Western Hemisphere, 8 Africans, 70 non-whites, 30 whites, 70 non-Christians, 30 Christians, 70 illiterate, 50 malnourished, 80 with sub-standard housing, 1 with a college education, 1 with a computer, 50% of the total wealth would be in the hands of 6 (all from the US)

The solution to global problems begins not with IQ, but rather, I CAN, I WILL, I MUST. Spread the seeds of Rotary Foundation. Plant people- We are the seeds.

Jeff told us that polio eradication would not have happened without the intervention of Rotary International. RI is also involved in many other global projects including food, health care and clean water. This contributes to global peace which, Jeff says, will only happen with the help of Rotary International. IT STARTS WITH YOU.
