SPEAKER'S REVIEW by Faith Woodward

Motivating Volunteers was the topic discussed by our speaker, Michelle Pepe from TrainingCorp, Inc. **Dave Rayburn** informed us of her experience in leadership and management, and her establishing TrainingCorp, Inc in 2000 after obtaining a

BA from Penn State and a master's degree from Temple.

Michelle identified four sources of motivation for volunteers. Meaning- how an individual views the significance of the organization and its work, Progress- the individual must have a sense of accomplishment, Competence- how an individual's unique knowledge and skill level can be used and the individual must feel he or she is competent, and Choice- the ability to exercise some control over one's involvement.

Minimize sources of dissatisfaction such as unreasonable demands, inadequate resources and training, no perceived growth opportunities, poor relationships with colleagues, poor management behavior, lack of regular feedback on performance, and lack of recognition. These can be minimized by asking questions both written and verbal in surveys or at meetings, setting up mentors, and looking for what people are doing right not wrong. A survey for Rotarian volunteers could ask, "What would an ideal club be like?" "What are the strengths of the club?" and "What are the challenges of the club?"

Michelle gave us much to think about and **President –Elect Annalie** took a lot of notes!
